## Here's how it works:

- Teams will be made up of a Heavy Fighter, a Rapier Fighter, a Creative-type and a Herald. Teams can be made up of members of any group. Any member of the team can double as the Herald.
- Teams will visit various stations around the site as they pursue their Quest. There they will battle, perform, and cogitate for treasure.
- Audience members can either park themselves at a station or follow their favorite team around to the different Quest stations.
- Best of all, audience members have the ability to help their favorite teams out! Small tasks—and rewards—will be available just for the audience, and those rewards may be kept or given to any adventurer in play.
- At the end of the day, the teams with the most treasure will compete for the grandest prize of all, the title of the very first GGASSC Champions—and maybe something a little extra...
