Directions: From I-10, take Canal road, exit 31, go South to 28th St., turn right (West) and go to first traffic light at Klondyke Rd. Turn left, and continue South. You will pass a traffic light at Commission Road, continue straight (South). In about ¼ mile, look for a Y intersection and take the left fork. St. Patrick’s is the first church on your left (white with green accents).

From Biloxi, Gulfport, or other areas along the beach, take Hwy 90 to Long Beach, turn North onto S. Cleveland. Go over the tracks and continue North onto N. Cleveland. Drive past Long Beach School. St. Patrick’s is the 2nd Church on the right, after the school. Church is white with Green accents.
